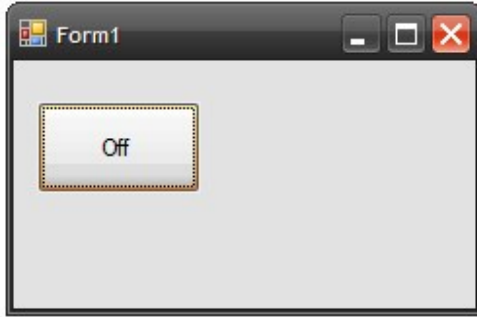

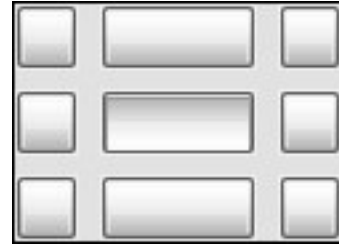

Button Control



TextAlign Property



Using the ToolBox, draw a **Button** Control on your Form. The default name of the Button is Button1.

Change the **Text** property of Button1 to "Off" using the Properties box.

Double-click on Button1 to bring up a window where you can attach code to the button.

Insert the following code:

```
Button1.Text = "off"
```

When the program is running, and Button1 is pressed, the above code will be executed, resulting in the text being displayed in Label1.

Modify the code as follows:

```
If Button1.Text = "on" Then
    Button1.Text = "off"
Else
    Button1.Text = "on"
End If
```

Including a Hot Key

You can include a **Hot Key** for a Button Control by inserting an ampersand (&) in front of the character you want in the **Text** property.

Image Property

You can include an image on the button by using the **Image** property.
