# Timer Control

---

## Enabled Property

Set to **True** to enable the Timer.  
Set to **False** to disable the Timer.

## Interval Property

Controls how often the Timer "fires". The setting is in milliseconds.

Example: To create a Timer with 5 seconds interval, set the interval to 5000.

## Starting and Stopping the Timer

To start the Timer ...

```
Timer1.Start()
```

To stop the Timer ...

```
Timer1.Stop()
```

**Note:** The Start() and Stop() methods simply change the Enabled property of the Timer.

Place the code that you want to be executed when the Timer fires in ... **Timer1\_Tick**
